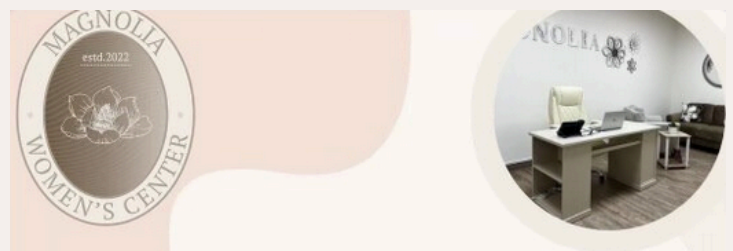
Coming up this month!

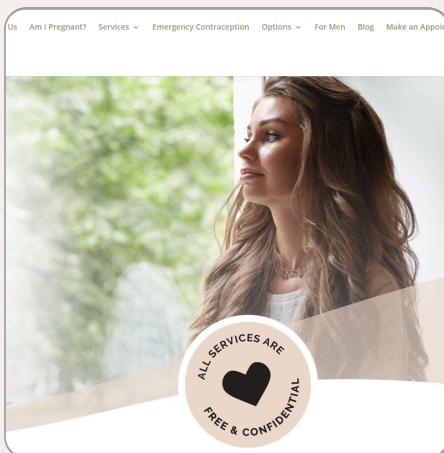

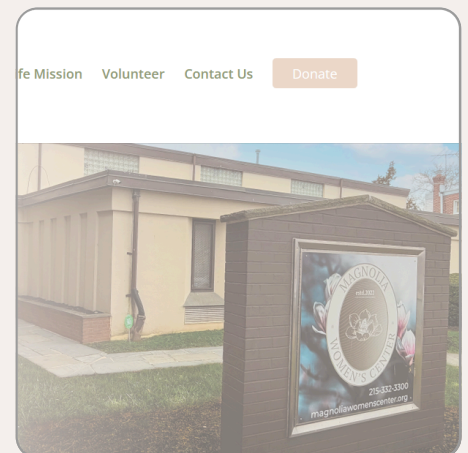

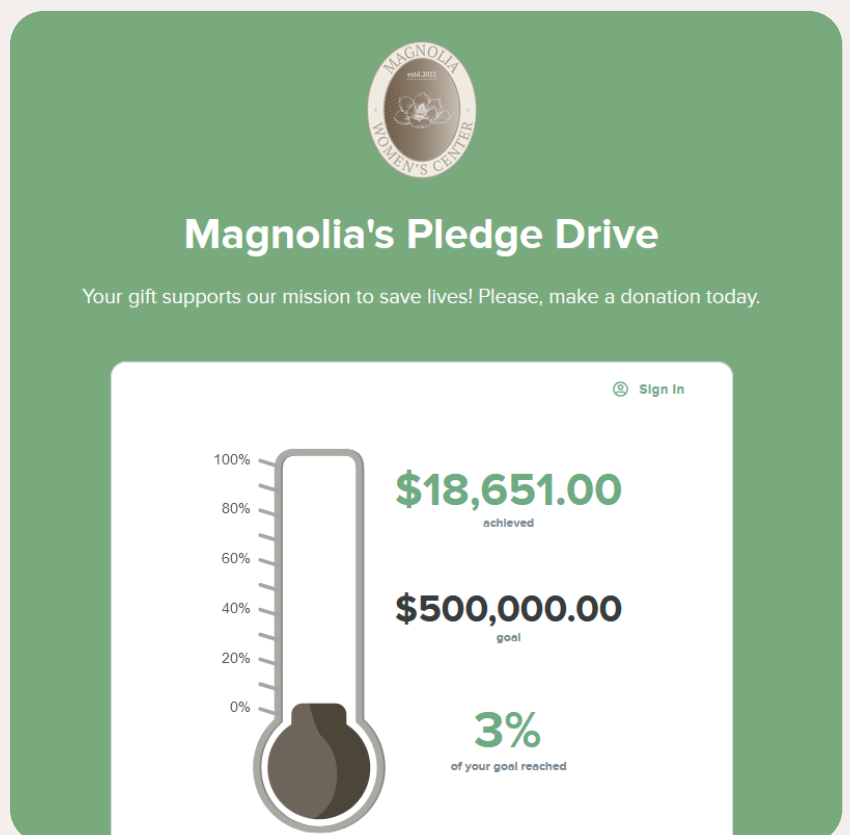
